3. Preparation for First Day of Term 3

All pupils should report to school in PE attire on the first day of Term 3. They should bring Book B or Part 2 of their textbooks and workbooks. All report books should be returned to the class Form Teacher. Parents who have not collected their children's report books should call at the General Office during the school holiday to pick them up. A grooming and attire check will be carried out on the first day of term. Please ensure that your child comes properly attired with a neat hairdo and short, clean nails. Name tags should be replaced if they have dropped off or faded.

4. Temperature-taking Exercise – Friday, 30 June 2017

The termly temperature-taking Exercise is conducted to ensure that the school is operationally ready for a pandemic. Please ensure that your child's oral digital thermometer is in working condition for the exercise.

5. Cyberwellness Week

We will be conducting a Cyber Wellness Week from 4 July to 7 July. There will be fun-filled activities which focus on helping pupils navigate safely online.

We also believe in partnering parents to guide and support their children at home. Our children, like us, interact with their friends through digital activities, such as online gaming and social media, and use the internet to learn about the world. Whilst we may think that our children are often more digitally savvy than we are, they still need our guidance to balance their on- and off-line activities and to be responsible and safe online. 6. Self-directed Learning

To facilitate self-directed learning during the June holidays, Computer Lab 1 will be opened for free access from 29 May to 31 May, 9.00 am to 11.00 am and 1.00 pm – 3.00 pm. Pupils can come to school to complete their online assignments if they do not have internet access at home. Pupils need to be in their school attire.

7. P1 Registration Exercise – Phase 1

Parents with children born between 2 Jan 2011 and 1 Jan 2012 eligible for the upcoming P1 Registration Exercise would have received a letter of notification and submitted the P1 Registration Form by Monday, 22 May 2015 through their older children who are current pupils of the school. Please inform the General Office immediately if you have not received the letter/form.

8. Lost and Found

9. P3 Mother Tongue (MT) 'B' Books

We have been informed by the bookshop vendor that the P3 MT (Chinese, Malay & Tamil) 'B' books will be available from 26 May 2017. The cost of each full set of books is as follows:

10. Bookshop / Library Opening Hours

11. After-School Programmes

Some of our pupils are involved in after-school programmes such as remedial lessons, enrichment programmes, mother tongue classes, CCA training, etc. These pupils should remain in school during the interval between dismissal and their after-school programmes. However, we understand that some programmes start at or after 3.30pm. If you plan to have your child leave the school for lunch and return to the school after that, please inform the teacher in-charge of the programme.
